Presentations

Regional Music Educator of the Year

Marlo Zumbrunn was recognized for being selected as the Regional Music Educator of the Year. Dr. Guy presented her with a certificate of recognition. Principal Ron Wilson spoke about the great qualities of Mrs. Zumbrunn.

Recognition of State Wrestlers

The Abilene State Wrestling team and coaches were recognized. Each wrestler stated their weight class and where they placed at state. The coaches were also introduced. It was noted that the wrestlers were recognized in Topeka on the House and Senate Floors.

State & Regional Wrestling Coach of the Year

James Stout was recognized for being named the State and Regional Wrestling Coach of the Year. Dr. Guy presented him with a certificate of recognition. Mr. Stout credited his awards to his wrestlers' achievements and to his assistant coaches.

Newspaper Staff Recognition

Doin' It Right Staff Spotlight

Diana Wildman was selected as the Doin' It Right Staff for the month of April. Diana is a para at McKinley and has worked at Abilene for 10 years. She was described as a person who is here for the kids and a team player.

Gwendolyn Jordan and Family Fund for Music Education Grant

The Abilene Middle School received a \$2400 grant from the Gwendolyn Jordan and Family Fund for Music Education that is with the Community Foundation of Dickinson County. Debby Barbur moved to graciously accept the grant. Jeff Bathurst seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Facilities & Technology

Legislative Update/Yearend Budget Projections

Dr. Guy updated the board on the proposed legislative funding formula stating that it was positive for the district. She also presented an estimated yearend budget projection which included \$700,000 in capital outlay projects and \$80,000 for Instructional Resources. With this proposal, the district would over spend by \$268,408, which would spend down some of the reserves just as the board had wanted.

Items for Disposal

A list of item for disposal was complied by Dave Canfield. Jeff Bathurst moved to approved the list of items for disposal. Debby Barbur seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0

Capital Project List

Dr. Guy presented the capital project list totaling \$701,091. Discussion was held. Kari Porter-Murray moved to approve the capital outlay project list as presented. Debby Barbur seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Garfield Purchasing Proposal

Gilmore and Associates sent a letter asking the board to sign a letter of agreement to stop negotiations on Garfield for 60 days while Gilmore and Associates completed their study and get a possible proposal back to the district for the purchase of Garfield. Discussion was held. Kari Porter-Murray moved to approve the 60-day Gilmore Proposal starting today. Jeff Bathurst seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Community Engagement

Free Summer Lunch Program Update

Food Service Director, Kyleen Harris, updated the board on the free summer lunch program available to kids ages 1 - 18 years old. It will be at the McKinley school starting June 5. Adults are allowed to eat, but will be charged \$3.50 per meal. There will be activities incorporated into the program.

Food Service 2017-2018 Meal Price Increase Proposal

Food Service Director, Kyleen Harris requested a \$.15 increase in lunch prices. This would allow the district to stay within the federal guidelines. The breakfast prices would remain the same. Jeff Bathurst moved to approve the increase as proposed. Debby Barbur seconded the motion. The motion carried 4-0.

Student Development

2017-2018 Instructional Resources

Chris Cooper updated the board on the new proposal for instructional resources. The total cost would be \$71,837.57. The Dave Ramsey's Personal Finance is sponsored by Astra Bank at no cost to the district.

Gregg Noel arrived at 7:47.

Debby Barbur moved to approve the 2017-18 Instructional Resources as presented. Jeff Bathurst seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

MTSS Behavior Information

Chris Cooper presented a powerpoint presentation on data collected concerning attendance, office discipline referrals, and course grades. Dr. Guy stated that the data is complied every 9 weeks to see the progress. The information also showed the trends at each building level. The staff will continue to look at the information, integrate it, make sure it is sustainable, and then merge it with the KESA process.

Social Worker Proposal

Dr. Guy presented a proposal to hire a social worker in place of a 1st grade teacher. This would relieve some of the administrators duties and would benefit the students. Discussion was held. Gregg Noel moved to advertise for a social worker. Debby Barbur seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

2017-2018 KASB Membership Renewal/Legal Assistance Fees
