Check which scholarship(s) you are applying for

- Abilene High School Athletic Scholarship** (\$1,000) – Applicant would be an outstanding performer in athletics, lettered in two sports and/or lettered two years in one sport, and made a positive contribution to the team, school, and community. **3 recommendations (coach, teacher, one more)** GPA 2.7 or higher

- Dickinson County Realtors Scholarship** (\$1,000) - Applicants is involved in high school and community activities, particularly those relating to the college major chosen. **1 teacher recommendation** GPA 2.0 or higher

- Karl Heins Glatt Scholarship** (\$1,000) – Karl Heins Glatt was a graduate of Abilene High School and Washburn University. He was employed by AT&T until his retirement. He was the son of Oren & Harriet Glatt of Abilene. The applicant involved in community service. **0 recommendations**

- Humpert Senior Scholarship** (\$1,000) – This scholarship is in memory of Carl and Arloyene Humpert who grew to adulthood in Dickinson County. They had a very successful farming venture in Nebraska and returned to this area to be close to family during retirement. They had no children of their own, but believed in the importance of investing in the future of our youth. Applicants have participated in AHS activities and have a financial need. **1 teacher recommendation** GPA 3.2 or higher

- Larry & Carol Lady Family Scholarship** (\$500) – This scholarship was established by Larry & Carol Lady to honor the life and work of their family members, Luther & Mildred lady, Gerald & Auline Lady, and George & Helen Hawks, who graduated from Abilene High School. The applicant is involved in activities at school, in the community, and/or at church; and community service. **3 recommendations (no relatives)** GPA 3.0 or higher

- Don Meeker Scholarship** (\$3,000) – Don Meeker was born Sept. 25, 1939, in Abilene, the son of James Roy and Mabel Meeker. He grew up in the Talmage area and attended local schools. After graduation he attended KSU. Mr. Meeker was disabled in a farming accident in 1959. He made his home in Abilene and worked for Memorial Hospital and the United Way. Mr. Meeker passed away in 2000 and his estate made a very generous contribution to the Abilene Public Schools Endowment Fund which made this scholarship possible. Mr. Meeker was very interested and supportive of the community. This scholarship continues his support by helping graduates of the community to further

their education. Applicant is involved in community service, athletics, fine arts, and school leadership. **0 recommendations** GPA 3.3 or higher
